Why would I be interested you ask? Here are the SOME of the reasons you'll want to take part in the choir program at St. John's.

- Children's Choir is FUN, EXCITING, and ENERGETIC.
- In children's choir you'll get to not only sing really cool songs but also learn to play percussion instruments, orff instruments, and lots of other neat things.
- You'll get to sing songs that are fun and for your age (not those old boring songs the adults sometimes sing!!!)
- You'll get to sing with kids your age - many of your friends from school and church.

**Parents: This year we will be doing things a little differently in hopes of allowing for more creativity in our program and flexibility in YOUR schedules! We are offering two 12 week "sessions" of choir. Your child may sign up for one or both of the following...**

- A. Our fall session will be September —November finishing with a Christmas Musical/Pageant on December 4<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm. Both choirs will meet at the usual time and the rehearsals will be centered around learning musical/spoken parts for the Christmas production.**
- B. The spring session will be from January 25<sup>th</sup> — April 25<sup>th</sup> finishing with a worship celebration in the 11:00 services on April 29<sup>th</sup>. Each choir will work on music to sing in worship once a month as well as have opportunities to play bells, orff instruments, drums, and learn sign language. There also may be opportunities for the older singers to try out some interpretive dance if they are interested.**

Rehearsals are **Wednesday from 5:30-6:15** and we will start **September 7<sup>th</sup>**. The registration sheet is attached.
